

A Message from Kimberly Shriner, M.D.

In order to be effective, the current vaccines require two doses - 21 days after the first dose for Pfizer and 28 days after the first dose for Moderna. **Please be vigilant about scheduling your second dose on time, even if the systems for doing so are cumbersome. The second dose is critical for your protection.**

After you have received both doses, you must give your immune system time – a minimum of two and ideally six weeks – to have the full benefit of vaccination. Please note, the variants circulating now are very contagious and everyone should get vaccinated when it is their turn to do so.
