Grants for health-related needs

If you or someone you know needs help with a health-related need that isn't covered by other sources, Senior Care Network's Senior Caring Fund might be able to help.

The Senior Caring Fund supports older adults (50+) in the Greater San Gabriel Valley who can benefit from a purchase of equipment, services, or supplies.

Requests should be for a one-time or short-term need not exceed a cost of \$500. Applicants can apply more than once.

Eligible items and services

- Blood pressure monitors
- Eyeglasses
- Dental expenses
- Utility payments to prevent adverse health outcomes
- Telehealth equipment
- Minor home modifications for improved safety
- Small appliances
- Grocery items

Emergency relief grants available

- Small appliances and other household items

- Other recovery needs
